entered its Order Appointing Michael J. Fitzgibbons Receiver, which appointed Michael J. FitzGibbons as Receiver of the Receivership Entities. These two orders are referred to hereafter as the "Receivership Order".

- 2. Pursuant to Order Re: Petition No. 1 the Court approved the Receiver's compensation at the rate of \$275 per hour together with all reasonable costs and expenses incurred relating to these services as Receiver. These services are billed by and paid to the Receiver's firm, FitzGibbons and Company, Inc.

- 4.
